WEEK 1: ALLEGHENY AT THIEL

Are you ready for some Thursday night football? For the first time in program history the Thiel Tomcats will open the season on campus under the lights on a Thursday night when they host local rival Allegheny at Alumni Stadium.

Thursday night football is a growing trend across the country, including the NCAA Division III level which will contest 11 games on the night of Aug. 31 according to D3football.com.

Thursday's non-conference game between Thiel and Allegheny is the last in a four-game series which began in 2014. The Tomcats won the last three games of the series. Thiel won 44-21 in 2016, 37-21 in 2015 and 28-14 in 2014. However, Allegheny leads the all-time series against Thiel, 40-35-6.

Last year the Tomcats racked up 302 rushing yards against the Gators led by **Nick Barca's** 123-yard performance which included one touchdown. Thiel's defense also came up with six turnovers, including a pair of interceptions by linebacker **Jake Elk**, who compiled 106 return yards.

The Tomcats went on to finish 4-6 in 2016 under first-year head coach Dan Blume. Thiel was predicted to finish eighth in the conference in 2017, according to the PAC Preseason Football Poll.

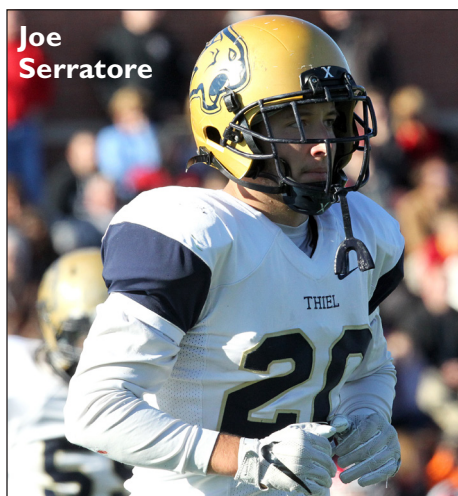

Last Year's Opener

The Thiel Tomcats ran for 302 yards and five touchdowns to lead the Thiel Tomcats to a 44-21 season-opening non-conference win over the Allegheny Gators at Frank Fuhrer Field.

Peyton Hicks was instrumental early. He scored touchdowns on runs of 40 and 10 yards in the first quarter to cap off a pair of seven-play drives that propelled the Tomcats to an early 14-0 lead. Nick Barca scored on a 15-yard run early in the second quarter, and the Tomcats went into the locker room at halftime with a 21-0 lead.

Thiel scored on the opening possession of the second half. After a trio of carries by Barca, Ryan Radke threw his first touchdown pass of the season, a 23-yarder down the far side of the field, to tight end Ryan Rowland.

Allegheny scored a pair of touchdowns in the third quarter, but Thiel countered with a 30-yard touchdown run by James Lewis to take a 34-14 lead into the final frame.

Colin Peal nailed a 31-yard field goal for the Tomcats less than a minute into the fourth quarter, but Tyler Balla scored a touchdown for the Gators with 9:42 remaining to cut the lead down to 16 points. Lewis went on to seal the win for the Tomcats with 3:30 remaining when he scored on a 46-yard run.

Barca led Thiel with 123 yards while scoring one touchdown. Radke completed 8-of-10 passes for 148 yards. He threw one touchdown pass and also ran for 33 yards.

Gator Logan Lee completed 11-of-24 passes for 117 yards in the second half. Balla paced the Gators with 123 yards on the ground.

Thiel's defense forced six turnovers on the night, three interceptions and three fumbles. Linebacker Jake Elk intercepted two passes and picked up 106 return yards.

The win was the first for Dan Blume, who was making his debut as head coach of the Tomcats.

Scheme Changes

Thiel's defense will switch from a 3-3-5 defense to a 3-4 scheme this season.

All-PAC Honorees

Two All-PAC Honorable Mention selections from 2016 return for the Tomcats this season - Elk and Barca. Barca finished second on the team in rushing yards (655) and scored five rushing touchdowns a season ago. Elk led the Tomcats and finished seventh in the PAC in tackles (82) last season.

Returners

The Tomcats enter the 2017 season with 21

returning letterwinners and 18 returning starters. On offense, seven letterwinners and seven starters return while 11 letterwinners and eight starters are back on defense. Thiel also returns three starters and three letterwinners on special teams.

Last Game

The last time the Tomcats were on the field they held off a late fourth-quarter comeback by the Grove City Wolverines to win the Mercer County Cup for the third consecutive year, 47-41.

Radke factored in on six touchdowns. He went 17-of-26 passing for 317 yards and four touchdowns through the air. On the ground, he carried 22 times for 131 yards and two more scores. With his rushing performance, Radke passed Steve Minton to become Thiel's all-time career rushing leader.

Rowland caught a touchdown pass from Radke late in the third quarter. Barca tallied 120 yards on the ground on 17 carries. Seven different Tomcats caught a pass from Radke.

Elk and defensive end Cody Wagner led the Tomcats on defense. Elk tallied a game-best 13 tackles, 2.5 of which were behind the line of scrimmage. Wagner contributed 10 tackles, two of which were for a loss of yards. Elk and Wagner also recorded one sack apiece. Also on defense for the Tomcats, Joe Serratore had seven tackles.

Radke's third touchdown pass to DeShawon Bracy gave the Tomcats a 47-41 lead with just over three minutes left in regulation. With the result still undecided, the Wolverines sought the game-tying touchdown on the ensuing possession. Grove City quarterback Brett Laffoon threw a deep pass on first-and-10 from his own 20-yard line, but the pass was intercepted to seal the win for Thiel.

Captains Named

Seniors Justin Zinsmeister, Rowland, Serratore and Elk were selected as the team's 2017 captains.

Thiel in Openers

Thiel is 3-7 in its last 10 season-openers. However, the Tomcats have won their last three season-openers.

The Thiel College Department of Athletics extended its partnership with News Talk 790 AM WPIC, a Cumulus station, to deliver multi-platform radio broadcasts of all 10 Thiel football games this season. In addition to the regular

Fans can continue to listen to Thiel's football games online at 790WPIC.com and ThielAthletics.com. **Hugh Ringer**, voice of the Tomcats, and **Don Achenbach '77** return to the booth to call all the action for the Tomcats in 2017.

Coaching Staff

Tim Heffernan and **Matt Arshinkoff** were both promoted in the offseason to titles of offensive and defensive coordinator, respectively. New coaches on Blume's staff this season include: **Mike Schuff** (pass game coordinator/quarterbacks), **Shamar Greene** (wide receivers), **Zen Bliss** (tight ends), **Jack Finch Jr.** (defensive line) and student assistant **RayShaun Nevins**, who will work primarily with the team's running backs.

ABOUT THE PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

The Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) was formally organized in 1955 by Western Reserve University, John Carroll University, Case Institute of Technology, and Wayne State University.

The PAC and its membership continue its original, defining mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence.

Currently comprised of 10 select private institutions – Bethany College, Chatham University, Geneva College, Grove City College, Saint Vincent College, Thiel College, Thomas More College, Washington & Jefferson College, Waynesburg University and Westminster College – the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics. With academics at the center of each member's philosophy, the PAC is built on the principle that an athletic program is a part of college life, but not an entity in itself.

The PAC expanded its membership to seven members in 2005 with the addition of Thomas More, formerly a NCAA Division III independent. Saint Vincent, a former NAIA member, joined the conference in 2006 as it began its reclassification to NCAA Division III status. Another former NAIA member, Geneva, became the conference's ninth member and began league play in 2007 as it started its NCAA Division III reclassification. Chatham became the league's 10th member, also in 2007.

In 2012, the PAC Presidents' Council voted to add Carnegie Mellon University and Case Western Reserve University as affiliate members in the sport of football beginning with the 2014 season.

The PAC crowns league champions and awards all-conference honors in its 21 championship sports. Head coaches determine all-PAC squads for all team sports, while in individual sports, such as cross country and tennis, All-PAC accolades are based upon performances at the conference championships.

In addition to its 21 sponsored championship sports, the PAC partnered with the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC) to create the single-sport Ohio River Lacrosse Conferences (ORLC & ORWLC) in 2014, with both kicking off league schedules during the spring of 2015.

The PAC annually awards its men's and women's All-Sports Trophies to the schools which perform best across the board in PAC competition.
