WEEK 4: THIEL AT CASE WESTERN RESERVE

he Tomcats will head to Cleveland Saturday to face the 18th-ranked Case Western Reserve Spartans under the lights at DiSanto Field.

Thiel is coming off a tough 27-14 loss to Geneva.

Freshman receiver Devin Turner caught two touchdown passes in the loss, a 21-yarder in the second quarter and a 45-yarder late in the fourth quarter.

Quarterback Marko Bakovic completed 17-of-33 passes for 211 yards in the loss.

Dusty Maines and Cody Wagner led Thiel's defense with 15 and 14 tackles, respectively.

Case Western Reserve is off to a 2-0 start after defeating Rochester (38-10) and Grove City (49-23). Freshman quarterback Drew Saxton has completed 47-of-69 passes (68.1%) for 595 yards and five touchdowns.

Justin Phan has caught 19 of Saxton's passes while Colt Morgan has caught all five of Saxton's touchdown passes.

Linebackers Isaac Withrow and Travis Johnston lead the Spartans with 16 and 15 tackles, respectively.

Case's defense has two interceptions on the year and 16 pass breakups.



Geneva Outdistances Thiel

Freshman **Devin Turner** caught two touchdown passes from **Marko Bakovic**, but it wasn't enough for the Thiel Tomcats in a 27-14 Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) loss to the Geneva Golden Tornadoes at Alumni Stadium Saturday night.

Geneva scored first with 6:19 remaining in the first quarter when Levi Cook scored on a 14-yard run to cap off an 11-play drive that consumed 5:30 of the game clock.

The Tomcats tied up the game on their next drive when Bakovic connected with Turner from 21 yards out to complete a 7-play drive in a little less than three minutes.

The Golden Tornadoes surged ahead early in the second quarter when Frankie Centofanti scored on a nine-yard run. Geneva added to its lead with 2:02 left before halftime when Trewon Marshall scored on a five-yard run. Marshall's touchdown run finished an 11-play drive that covered 74 yards. The extra point was blocked, but Geneva held a 20-7 lead at the break.

Marshall ran for a game-best 127 yards on 27 carries. His long run on the night was a 13-yard-er. Cook also ran for 84 yards and a score on 15 totes.

The third quarter was scoreless, but the Golden Tornadoes added to their lead early in the fourth frame when linebacker Tyler Cann picked off a pass and ran 16 yards down the near side of the field for his team's fourth touchdown of the game.

Turner caught his second touchdown pass of the game, this one a 45-yarder, from Bakovic with 1:17 remaining in regulation.

Bakovic completed 17-of-33 passes for 211 yards. He threw two touchdown passes and one interception. Turner caught two passes for 66 yards, both of which went for touchdowns. **Nick Barca** paced the Tomcats with 31 yards on ground on 13 carries.

Dusty Maines and **Cody Wagner** led the Tomcats with 15 and 14 tackles, respectively. Wagner also recovered a fumble, which was forced by **Brody Suter**.

Cann led Geneva with six tackles and an interception, which he returned 16 yards for a touchdown. Jacob Robertson and Kendrick Wells combined for five sacks.

Scouting Case Western Reserve

The 18th-ranked Spartans, according to D3football.com, enter Saturday's game 2-0 overall and 1-0 in PAC play. Case Western Reserve opened the season with a 38-10 non-conference win over Rochester and defeated Grove City last

Saturday, 49-23.

Freshman quarterback Drew Saxton has completed 47-of-69 passes (68.1%) for 595 yards. He has thrown five touchdown passes and one interception.

Sam Jenkins and Zach Hall lead the Spartans on the ground with 115 and 89 yards, respectively. Each has scored one rushing touchdown.

Justin Phan has been Saxton's top target with 164 yards on 19 receptions. Colt Morgan also has 10 receptions, five of which were for touchdowns, for 145 yards.

Inside linebackers Isaac Withrow and Travis Johnston lead the Spartans with 16 and 15 tackles, respectively. The Spartans have intercepted two passes on the year and broken up 16 passes.

Thiel vs. CWR in 2017

The 16th-ranked Case Western Reserve Spartans outscored the Thiel Tomcats 21-7 in the first quarter and never looked back en route to a 63-28 PAC win.

The Spartans scored on the opening drive of the game when Rob Cuda tossed a 12-yard touchdown pass to Zak Hurd to cap off an 8-play drive that covered 68 yards in a little less than three minutes.

The Tomcats came right back with a long drive of their own and tied up the score 7-7 when Ronald Brown threw a 4-yard touchdown strike to David Aumuller to finish a 9-play effort over 81 yards in 3:23.

Case Western scored touchdowns on its next two possessions to claim a 21-7 lead after 15 minutes of play. Jacob Burke scored on a 1-yard run while Zech Medved caught a 60-yard touchdown pass from Cuda.

Thiel got a spark on **Darien Mosley**'s 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown early in the second quarter, but Case Western Reserve led 49-14 at halftime.

Thiel's defense forced a fumble early in the third quarter, which Wagner returned 60 yards to the Case Western 6-yard line. Wagner's return set up a touchdown for the Tomcats on a 5-yard halfback pass from Barca to Jaime Sommers.

The Tomcats scored another touchdown roughly five minutes later after the defense forced another fumble. After driving down to the Case Western 2-yard line, Brown's pass on third-andgoal from 2-yard line was intercepted by Patrick Crossey, but the ball was stripped by Gary Hiner and recovered by Sommers in the end zone for a Thiel touchdown.

The Spartans finished the game with two unanswered touchdowns, one on a 30-yard run by

Myles Anthony late in the third quarter and one on a 3-yard run by Zach Hall early in the fourth quarter.

Cuda completed 17-of-22 passes for 343 yards. He threw five touchdown passes. Burke led the Spartans with 55 yards on the ground and one score. Hurd caught seven passes, two of which were touchdown receptions, for 132 yards.

Barca paced the Tomcats with 95 yards rushing on 16 carries. Sommers caught three passes, one of which was a touchdown grab, for 23 yards.

Joe Serratore led the Tomcats on defense with 12 tackles. Wagner recorded eight tackles, four of which were behind the line of scrimmage. Wagner also recorded two sacks and a 60-yard fumble recovery return.

Bakovic has completed 52 passes on the year for 543 yards, the fourth most in the PAC ... Mosley leads the PAC in kick return average (22.0) ... **Dylan Kleckner** averages 39.7 yards per punt, the second best in the PAC ... Dylan Kleckner also owns the longest punt in the PAC, a 62-yarder ... Maines leads the PAC with 36 tackles on the year ... Wagner ranks tied for third in the conference with 26 tackles.

ABOUT THE PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

The Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC), built on the basic belief that an athletic program is an integral part of college life, but not an entity in itself, looks back on over sixty years of growth and ahead to years of continued academic and athletic excellence.

The league's name clearly reflects its founding principle that operational control of all aspects of intercollegiate athletics is ultimately the responsibility of the presidents of each member institution, and thus active presidential leadership and oversight is paramount in conference administration.

Formally organized in 1955 by Western Reserve University, John Carroll University, Case Institute of Technology, and Wayne State University, the PAC was the result of a realization that college athletics, despite numerous virtues for the individual and the institution, were gradually becoming a financial and academic burden. If athletics were to be continued, action had to be taken to place the program on its proper level. This included the premise that benefits of participation should be provided to as many students as possible. The PAC and its membership continue its original, defining mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence.

Institutions involved understand that the key components to its progress lie in the foundation of faith in each member by each other member. It is the conviction of its membership that the PAC is the solution to the dilemma of intercollegiate athletic competition, and they have staked their athletic future on this premise.

Currently comprised of nine select private institutions – Bethany College, Chatham University, Geneva College, Grove City College, Saint Vincent College, Thiel College, Washington & Jefferson College, Waynesburg University and Westminster College – the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics, with academics at the center of each member's philosophy.

The PAC expanded its membership to seven members in 2005 with the addition of Thomas More College, formerly a NCAA Division III independent. Thomas More's 12-year membership in the PAC ended with the conclusion of the 2017-18 academic year. Saint Vincent, a former National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) member, joined the conference in 2006 as it began its reclassification to Division III status. Another former NAIA member, Geneva, became the conference's ninth member and began league play in 2007 as it started its Division III reclassification. Chatham became the league's 10th member, also in 2007.

In 2012, the PAC Presidents' Council voted to add Carnegie Mellon University and Case Western Reserve University as affiliate members in the sport of football beginning with the 2014 season. Franciscan University of Steubenville was accepted as an affiliate member in men's and women's lacrosse in December 2017 and will begin PAC play in 2019.

The PAC crowns league champions and awards all-conference honors in its 23 championship sports (12 men, 11 women). Head coaches determine all-PAC squads for all team sports, while in individual sports, such as cross country and golf, all-PAC accolades are based upon performances at the conference championships.

The PAC, which celebrated its 60th anniversary during the 2014-15 academic year, annually awards its men's and women's All-Sports Trophies to the schools which perform best across the board in PAC competition.

Staying true to its original mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence, the PAC has seen nearly 300 of its participating student athletes recognized as Academic All-Americans, while the league has also produced numerous NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship winners. Last year, the conference named a record 1,144 student-athletes to its PAC Academic Honor Roll, which recognizes all participating student-athletes who earn a term grade-point average of 3.60 or above.
