## WEEK 8: THIEL AT CARNEGIE MELLON

he Tomcats head to Pittsburgh Saturday to face the Carnegie Mellon Tartans. Kickoff for the PAC game is set for 1 p.m.

The Tartans opened the season 4-0, including a 20-13 win over then 12th-ranked W&J. However, CMU lost to Grove City in double-overtime (29-26) and Bethany (23-19) over the last three weeks.

Chris Haas leads CMU's running game with 415 yards and two touchdowns on 102 carries. Quarterback JD Dayhuff has completed 91-of-168 passes for 1,209 yards.

Alec Oshita and Willie Richter are the team's top receivers. Oshita has 24 receptions for 389 yards while Richter has caught 17 passes for 312 yards.

Outside linebacker Quinn Gaughan leads the Tartans on defense with 62 tackles, 8.5 of which have been for a loss of yards. Defensive ends Long Tran and Sam Brod have 13 combined sacks for CMU.

Thiel has benefited from four defensive and special teams touchdowns over the last three games.

Against Waynesburg, **Eligah Flynn** scored on a 38-yard interception return while **Trou Johnson** scored on an 86-yard return after recovering a fumble. Johnson went on to score on a 17-yard interception return against against Saint Vincent while **Darien Mosley** scored on a 91-yard kickoff return against Westminster.



#### <u>Titans too much for Tomcats</u>

The Thiel Tomcats lost a Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) game to the Westminster Titans 55-7 at Alumni Stadium on Saturday.

The Titans opened up a 27-0 first-quarter lead before **Darien Mosley** got the Tomcats on the scoreboard with a touchdown on a 91-yard kick-off return. In all, Mosley returned four kickoffs for 134 yards on Saturday.

Westminster went on to score three more touchdowns in the second quarter to hold a 48-7 lead at halftime

Keano Grice led Westminster with 116 yards and three touchdowns on 10 carries. Tyler Greene ran for 108 yards and one score on 22 totes.

Cole Konieczka completed 13-of-16 passes for 159 yards for the Titans. Konieczka threw three touchdown passes. **Marko Bakovic** completed four passes for 45 yards for the Tomcats.

Connor Cox led the Titans with five catches for 45 yards with two touchdowns. **Isaiah Harvin** led Thiel with two catches for 22 yards.

Cameron Prebble led Thiel with 16 tackles. Matt Crawford made 10 tackles, two of which were behind the line of scrimmage. Trou Johnson made six tackles and broke up three passes.

#### Scouting CMU

The Tartans opened the season 4-0 with wins over MIT (24-7), Geneva (31-6), then 12th-ranked W&J (20-13) and Saint Vincent (49-14). However, they have lost two of their last three games. CMU lost to Grove City in double-overtime (29-26), rebounded to defeat Waynesburg (24-3) before falling to Bethany (23-19) last Saturday.

Chris Haas leads the CMU running attack with 415 yards and two touchdowns on 102 attempts. Quarterback JD Dayhuff has completed 91-of-168 passes for 1,209 yards. Dayhuff has 12 TD passes on the season and seven INTs.

Alec Oshita and Willie Richter are the team's top receivers. Oshita has 24 receptions for 389 yards while Richter has 17 catches for 312 yards. Both have two touchdown catches on the year while Kris Hughes leads the team with six touchdown receptions.

Outside linebacker Quinn Gaughan leads the team with 62 tackles, 8.5 of which have been behind the line of scrimmage. Gaughan also has 2.5 sacks, two pass breakups, two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries on the season. Defensive ends Long Tran and Sam Brod lead the team with seven and six sacks, respectively.

#### Last Year Against CMU

The Tomcats suffered a 41-7 PAC loss to the

Carnegie Mellon Tartans at Alumni Stadium on Oct. 20, 2018.

The Tartans scored on the opening drive of the game when Rory Hubbard darted into the end zone from three yards out to cap off a nine-play effort.

The Tomcats drove the ball on their opening drive of the game, but Thomas Polutchko picked off a pass on a second-and-10 play at the Tartan 31-yard line and returned it 70 yards for a touchdown to open up a 14-0 lead.

Thiel's offense went back to work on the ensuing drive and cut the lead in half when Damon Smith threw a 36-yard touchdown pass to Devin Turner to cap off a 10-play drive that covered 73 yards and consumed 5:26 of the first quarter clock.

Carnegie Mellon went on to score 34 unanswered points over the remainder of the game while refusing to give up another point to Thiel.

Hubbard led the Tartans on the ground with 133 yards and a pair of scores on 20 carries. Alex Cline completed 13-of-16 passes for 157 yards. He threw one touchdown pass and one interception.

Carnegie Mellon's Karl Kumm recorded gamebests in receiving yards (71) and receptions (6). He caught a five-yard touchdown pass from Cline early in the second quarter. Kris Hughes also contributed five receptions for 52 yards.

Nick Barca paced the Tomcats with 101 rushing yards on 27 carries.

Cody Wagner led Thiel on defense with 10 tackles, two of which were behind the line of scrimmage.

Quinn Zsido recorded a game-best 13 tackles for the Tartans while Gaughan made 10 stops, all of which were solo efforts.

#### Remember When

Ryan Radke and Marcus Johnson figured in on five Thiel touchdowns to lead the Tomcats to a 40-27 PAC win over the Carnegie Mellon Tartans at Gesling Stadium on Nov. 1, 2014.

Radke scored the first touchdown of the game with 13:25 remaining in the second quarter on a 23-yard run around left end that capped off a 14-play, 80-yard drive that consumed nearly six minutes of the game clock. Colin Peal added the extra point to give Thiel a 7-0 lead.

Two drives later Radke helped increase Thiel's lead to 13-0 when he lobbed an 8-yard touch-down pass to Johnson in the back corner of the end zone. Johnson's touchdown catch finished off a 7-play, 59-yard drive.

The Tartans pieced together a good drive at the end of the second quarter and scored their first touchdown of the game on a one-yard run by Sam Benger with 27 seconds remaining before

halftime.

On the opening drive of the second half, Radke threw a 53-yard touchdown pass to Johnson, putting the finishing touches on a 5-play, 81-yard march that gave the Tomcats a 20-7 lead.

Radke and Johnson hooked up for another score two drives later. Radke completed three passes on the drive, all to Johnson, including a 44-yard touchdown throw that gave Thiel a 26-7 lead with 5:21 left in the third quarter.

Thiel fullback Rich Smallwood scored on a oneyard run early in the fourth quarter, to extend his team's lead to 33-7.

Andrew Hearon threw touchdown passes on back-to-back drives for the Tartans midway through the fourth quarter to cut Thiel's lead down to 33-20. However, the Tomcat offense responded with another long touchdown drive. this one a 9-play, 55-yard effort that concluded with an 8-yard run by Radke.

The Tartans closed out scoring when Evan Englert threw a 19-yard touchdown pass to Max Reinertsen with nine seconds remaining to play.

Radke completed 15-of-24 passes for 256 yards. He threw three TD passes, all to Johnson, and no INTs. Radke also led Thiel on the ground with 114 yards and two TDs on 11 totes.

Johnson caught seven passes, three of which went for touchdowns, for 165 yards.

#### ABOUT THE PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

The Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC), built on the basic belief that an athletic program is an integral part of college life, but not an entity in itself, looks back on over sixty years of growth and ahead to years of continued academic and athletic excellence.

The league's name clearly reflects its founding principle that operational control of all aspects of intercollegiate athletics is ultimately the responsibility of the presidents of each member institution, and thus active presidential leadership and oversight is paramount in conference administration.

Formally organized in 1955 by Western Reserve University, John Carroll University, Case Institute of Technology and Wayne State University, the PAC was the result of a realization that college athletics, despite numerous virtues for the individual and the institution, were gradually becoming a financial and academic burden. If athletics were to be continued, action had to be taken to place the program on its proper level. This included the premise that benefits of participation should be provided to as many students as possible. The PAC and its membership continue its original, defining mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence.

Institutions involved understand that the key components to its progress lie in the foundation of faith in each member by each other member. It is the conviction of its membership that the PAC is the solution to the dilemma of intercollegiate athletic competition, and they have staked their athletic future on this premise.

Comprised of 10 select private institutions -Bethany College, Chatham University, Franciscan University of Steubenville, Geneva College, Grove City College, Saint Vincent College, Thiel College, Washington & Jefferson College, Waynesburg University and Westminster College - the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics, with academics at the center of each member's philosophy.

In 2012, the PAC Presidents' Council voted to add Carnegie Mellon University and Case Western Reserve University as affiliate members in the sport

The PAC crowns league champions and awards allconference honors in its 23 championship sports. Head coaches determine All-PAC squads for all team sports, while in individual sports, such as cross country, golf and indoor and outdoor track and field, all-PAC accolades are based upon performances at the conference championships.

The PAC, which recently celebrated its 60th anniversary, annually awards its men's and women's All-Sports Trophies to the schools which perform best across the board in PAC competition.

Staying true to its original mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence, the PAC has seen over 200 of its participating student-athletes recognized as Academic All-Americans, while the league has also produced numerous NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship winners. Last year, the conference named 1,097 of its student-athletes to the PAC Academic Honor Roll, which recognizes all participating student-athletes who earn a term grade-point average of 3.60 or
